clares on - oath that it is bona fide his intention
to become a Citizen of the United States of America
and to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance and
fidelity to every foreign prince, potentate, State and
sovereignty whatsoever, particularly to the King of
Hanover of whom he was before a subject, and that
he will bear true allegiance to the United States and
support the Constitution of the same
