D. 18*64*; that it is his BONA FIDE intention to become a citizen of the United States, and renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State, or Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly any and all allegiance to the *Queen of Great Britain & Ireland* and that he will bear true allegiance to the United States, and support the Constitution of the same.
