Be it Remembered, That on this day, *Gustav Haenel*  
an alien, filed in open Court, and swore to the following petition, declaring his intention to become a  
Citizen of the United States of America, to-wit:

To the Honorable, the Judge of the City Court of Louisville:

Your petitioner, *Gustav Haenel* a native of *Germany*  
would respectfully state that he was born in *Prussia* that he emigrated  
to the United States of America, in the year *1857* and landed at *Galveston*  
in the State of *Texas*, Nov. 8. ~~1857~~ in the year *1857* that  
he is *31* years of age, that he has resided in the City of Louisville, Kentucky,  
about *one* years last past, that he is *—* feet *—* inches high, has *—*  
hair, *—* eyes, *—* complexion, and is *—* made, that it is bona fide his  
intention to become a Citizen of the United States of America, and absolutely and entirely to renounce  
and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any and every foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty  
whatever, and particularly to *Fredrick William IV King*  
*of Prussia*

to he now owes allegiance.
