D. 1848; that it is his Bona Fide intention to become a citizen of the United States, and Renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly any and all allegiance to the King of Prussia — and that he will bear true allegiance to the United States, and support the Constitution of the same.
