 heard the declarations <sup>under oath</sup> of said John Brendel and Joseph  
 Beckmann, and being satisfied that the said Lanning  
 Libber has faithfully complied with all the requirements  
 of the Naturalization Laws of the United States Congress,  
 and entitled to the benefits of the same, and he also having  
 taken ~~sworn to~~ and subscribed to the oath required by Law,

It is Therefore Ordered by The Court that the  
 said declaration and oath be recorded

and that the said Lanning Libber be admitted  
 and he is hereby admitted to be a Citizen of the United  
 States of America - and that the Clerk issue  
 to the said <sup>under his hands and the seal of the Court</sup> Lanning Libber, a Certificate  
 of Citizenship, after having first recorded  
 the same in the Records of this Court.
