declarations, on oath, of Peter Shields and Wm Lyons  
both citizens of the United States of America, that said Philip Dermody has  
resided within the limits and jurisdiction of the United States of America, for more than five  
years last past, and the last year thereof within the State of Texas; that during that time  
he has behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the  
~~Constitution of the United States of America, and well disposed to the good order and happiness~~  
of the same, and the said Philip Dermody having shown to  
the satisfaction of this Court that he has faithfully complied with all the requirements  
of the Naturalization Laws of the United States Congress, and is entitled to the  
benefits of the same, and he having also made oath of record in this Court that he  
will support the Constitution of the United States of America, and that he doth absolutely and entirely  
renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty  
whatever, and particularly to the Queen of Great Britain & Ireland  
of whom he was a subject.

It was therefore ordered by the Court, That the said
