Four brothers emigrated from east Georgia into newly opened Henry County Georgia in 1822. Benjamin and Silas MOSELEY remained in the County and put down deep roots which exist to this day. (Silas is my ancestor). Elisha (wife Susannah) was involved in the establishment of McDonough, the county seat. He left the county and may have been in Montgomery County Alabama in 1830. He next shows up Texas in 1845 and was instrumental in the establishment of Cherokee County. His whereabouts between 1830 and 1845 are completely unknown to me. Alanson (wife Sarah) remained in Henry County through 1840 but then in 1845 was involved in the establishment of Rusk. The Texas data on the two brothers I have learned from your excellent lookup service but that is about all I know about them except that there is a Moseley cemetery somewhere about 4 miles south of Rusk and that a descendant of Alanson, Minton Moseley was the Rusk town druggist for some years. I am scheduled to write an article on the four brothers for a forthcoming book "First Families of Henry County" and wish to know more about the Texas exploits of Elisha and Alanson Moseley so they can be included. I would appreciate anyone with information on the two communicating with me. I would particularly like to hear from descendants.

## Ancestor Swap Meet, June 27, 1998

Cherokee County Genealogical Society held its first ever Ancestor Swap Meet from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on June 27, 1998. Preregistrations numbered 137 and additional 32 registered at the event. 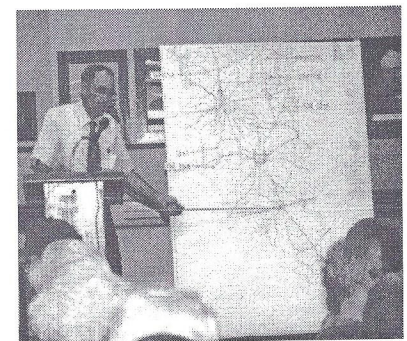

### CHARLES BOOTHE - 1812 Soldier

Charles Boothe was born ca 1785 in the State of Virginia and was a school-master by profession. He married Lucy Ann Abernathy (born ca 1785 in Brunswick Co, VA) on 24 June 1811.

Charles Boothe volunteered in Brunswick Co, VA in 1812 for a term of six months in the Virginia militia and continued in service except for a short time when he was furloughed because of sickness. He was promoted from private to quarter-master in Captain Fisher's Regiment of Virginia Volunteers, commanded by Colonel Jesse Reid in the War of 1812. He served from 31 July to 26 August 1814 in Captain Fisher's Co and in Major Perkins Regiment from 31 August 1814 to 10 Feb. 1815 according to the records of the Veterans' Administration.

Charles and Lucy Ann had 7 children, the oldest of which was George Winston Boothe, this writer's great-great-grandfather.

The family migrated to Mississippi Territory (later the State of Alabama) in 1819. They lived for many years in Limestone Co, AL near the Giles Co, TN border.

Charles died at his home in Limestone Co, AL 24 June 1845 and Lucy Ann died in 1870. Their exact burial place is uncertain, but descendants living in Giles Co, TN believe it to be in Mt. Carmel Cemetery in Giles Co, TN.

**Dr. David Carlisle Sharp was a successful doctor, senator, orator, farmer, and practiced law as well.**

I would like to submit information about a relative who was a resident of Cherokee county in the 1850's until his assassination in 1858, and would like it published in your newsletter. I will enclose some family group sheets on him and his heir, Tylee Sharp Johnson, plus census extracts, and newspaper articles that I obtained from the Mississippi State archives in Jackson, Mississippi, the library in Galveston, Texas, and the Mississippi law College in Jackson.

Dr. David Carlisle Sharp was a successful doctor, senator, orator, farmer, and practiced law as well. He lived on a farm at Larissa at the time of his death, and his estate was probated in Cherokee County.

Dr. D.C. Sharp left one descendent, as far as we know at the present time, Jeffie Lee Johnson Melton. Jeffie Lee was the daughter of Tylee Sharp Johnson and Alexander Campbell Johnson, a prominent local citizen known as "Uncle Alec": according to Alec's obituary (also enclosed) Jeffie Lee was the wife of Edgar Melton.

So far, we don't know what happened to Jeffie Lee Melton, or if she had any children. I would like to correspond with any people having information on Alexander and Tylee Sharp Johnson, or their daughter Jeffie Lee Melton and her family.

One Melton relative thought it possible the Jeffie Lee had twin daughters, Marie and Marjorie.

Also, Dr. D.C. Sharp was one of 3 Sharp brothers who settled in East Texas in the 1840's-1850's: Dr. William A. Sharp of San Augustine and Cherokee Counties, and James Sharp of Sabine County. Enclosed are group sheets and census extracts for their families.

## Dr. David Carlisle Sharp

David & Mary Sharp were in the 1850 Holmes Co. Mississippi census. Their son, David Tyler Sharp was enumerated with the Fatheree household there.

David Carlisle Sharp went by his middle name, David, after moving south. He was a Doctor, Farmer, and Senator from Holmes and Sunflower Counties. He also practiced law in Cherokee County, TX.

He was a senator representing the city of Jackson, Mississippi, on Friday, August 18, 1848, The Mississippian reported that he among others had addressed an organizational meeting on the county democrat party on Monday, August 14, 1848.

The Mississippian, City of Jackson, Friday Morning, June 1, 1849 reported that Dr. Sharp spoke at a political meeting: "Dr. D. Sharpe then addressed the people in defence (sic) of the administration and the war, and I assure you the Mexican Whigs caught it severely. He told the people he used to be a Whig--that he voted for Tippecanoe and honest John Tyler too, in 1841, and for Clay in 1844, but that he could not stand to go for the Mexican Whigs of 1848. His speech was received with great applause, to the great annoyance of some of our fancy Whigs who abuse him without measure. He has greatly improved in speaking since he went to the Senate, and will make a fine stump orator. He is a man of quick mind and always ready to reply, as some of our Whig friends know, and will recollect from his speech on Monday last. The Whigs elected Sharpe to the Senate by abusing him before, and will do so again if they pursue the same course against him."

The 1850 Holmes County Mississippi Census, Lexington (town) reports: Dwelling No. 301, Family number 301, D.C. Sharpe, age 35, Male, physician, \$100 value of real estate, born in New York; Mary E., age 22, female, born Mississippi, Rosetta A. Sharpe, age 11/12, female, born Mississippi. In the same household resided James Blade (or Belade), age 30, male, laborer, born in Georgia.

David was assassinated, account appeared in newspapers. The Natchez weekly Courier, dated Wednesday Morning, February 17. 1858 states: "Death of Dr. D.C. Sharp. Information has been received in Vicksburg that Dr. D.C. Sharp, formerly Senator from Holmes county, in the Mississippi Legislature, was killed on Tuesday last, at Wilmington by a pistol from John W. Wood, Esq. a \*\*\*\*\* lawyer. Dr. Sharp has been a citizen of Texas for a year or two past. \*\*\*\*\* means unreadable.

The Prairie News, Okolona, Miss., Thursday, March 18, 1858 stated: "Col. Wood, who recently killed Dr. D. C. Sharpe, in Lexington, Miss., was tried before magistrates and it was decided that he be refused bail. Afterward a habeas corpus being granted and a new hearing had, he was admitted to bail in the sum of ten thousand dollars. Insanity caused by mania portu was plead."

The Weekly News, Galveston, Texas, Tuesday, March 16, 1858 reported: " A Texian Killed -- We have just heard that Dr. D.C. Sharpe, of our county, was killed in the town of Lexington, Mississippi, by John W. Wood, Esq., on the 10th inst.

Dr. Sharpe had been a citizen of Cherokee county about three years, and during the past winter returned to Mississippi on business. We had the pleasure of a somewhat intimate acquaintance with the deceased, and always regarded him as man of superior natural and acquired endowments. For one term he represented the counties of Holmes and Sunflower in the Senate of Mississippi, and acted a conspicuous part in the political excitements which raged in his then adopted State during the stormy session of the 1849 and 50. Since his removal to Cherokee county he has not mingled, to any considerable extent in politics, but divided his time in the cultivation of his farm, and the practice of law and medicine. Superintending his farming interests in the spring and fall, practicing medicine during the summer, and attending to the District Courts of our county whenever in session.

His whole life has been an eccentricity, and its many remarkable phases would make the material of a better romance than probably half the yellow-covered pamphlets with startling names, which flood the country now-a-days. Yet with all his peculiarities and frailties (for who is not frail) he was very much loved by his friends, and by all esteemed as an upright generous and charitable man. He leaves an luterestling family to mourn his loss, and many, many friends to deplore his early death.--Rusk Enquirer."

## Alexander Campbell Johnson

From the Troup Banner, Wednesday April 29, 1926:

"Uncle Alec" Johnson Died at Troup Sunday  
Confederate Veteran and Prominent Mason;  
Pioneer of Troup Truck Industry

A.C. (Uncle Alec) Johnson died at the family home in South Troup Sunday morning. He was 82 years old. Funeral Services were conducted at the Bradford cemetery, Troup, Monday afternoon, interment being made at that cemetery under auspices of Dixie Lodge No. 272, A. F. and A. M. of Troup, in which Mr. Johnson was a highly honored member.

He is survived by his wife and one daughter, Mrs. Edgar Melton of Palestine.

Responding to a request made by Mr. Johnson shortly before he passed away, Henry Edwards, editor of The Troup Banner and the Tyler Journal, spoke at the funeral. A close friend of Mr. Johnson and his family for many years, Mr. Edwards told of the attributes which made the life of Mr. Johnson a constructive factor in the community, and endeared him to a vast number of people.

He was straightforward, honest, faithful, trustworthy and sincere alike in home, business and friendly relations. Mr. Edwards observed in the course of his talk.

Mr. Johnson lived in Troup for about 25 years. Before moving here, he lived on his farm near Griffin for many years. He had been a Mason for 61 years, being perhaps the oldest Mason here, in point of number of years of membership. He was married first to Miss Tylie Sharp at Griffin. After her death he was married to Mrs. Blow, who survives him.

As a youth he left college in his native state of Mississippi to join the Confederate Army. He served with Barksdale's Brigade, a Mississippi command that operated principally in

Virginia. He took part in all of the principal battles in Virginia during the Civil War, among which were the battles of Gettysburg and the Wilderness. He was a captive of the Federals for four months. He was paroled at the close of the war at Richmond, Virginia, from which place he returned to his home in Jackson, Hinds county, Mississippi, his birthplace.

Mr. Johnson was a pioneer in the tomato and truck industry in Troup, and took a leading part in introducing and establishing the industry here on a profitable basis for the town and community. He aided to a large extent in bringing about a cooperative plan of truck crop marketing here during the early days of the business."

The Tyler Daily Courier-Times dated Monday, April 26, 1929 stated: "Aged Ex-Confederate Veteran Died at Home at Troup--

Mr. A.C. Johnson, well known ex-Confederate veteran died Sunday morning at 9 o'clock, at his home there after an illness of about two weeks.

Funeral services were held this afternoon under the direction of the Masons at the Bradford cemetery, near Troup and was largely attended.

Mr. Johnson was 84 years of age and had resided in the Troup community for many years. He was born in Mississippi and came to Texas soon after the civil War in which he served with distinction.

Mr. Johnson enjoyed a wide acquaintance over this section and was a highly esteemed citizen.

Besides his aged widow, he is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Edgar Melton of Troup and one nephew, Judge J.A. Bulloch of this city."

## Fort Worth may lose National Archives

**I**n a story copyrighted Thursday, August 13, 1998 in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram, Laurie Mayk reported that the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) may move from Fort Worth.

The National Archives center on West Felix street houses federal treasures of Texas, Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico and Oklahoma. Many of the country's 13 regional sites are running out of room for permanent records and are struggling to prevent pollutants from damaging records.

The City of Fort Worth has an interest in buying the land where the archives are located from the federal government. Fort Worth Assistant City Manager Mike Groomer reported that negotiations have been ongoing for about 2½ years.

“The city's negotiations with the General Services Administration, the agency working with NARA's real estate broker, won't affect the agency's decision about what to do with the Southwest records. The agency is about a year away from a decision, but officials have assured genealogists that census and other records that are crucial to their research will stay in Fort Worth—even if the stacks of original documents do not. But many remain concerned.”

David L. White of Fort Worth <dlwhite@flash.net> sent e-mail to Texas Genealogists urging them to contact their elected representatives. “If they don't write now, the Southwest Branch will probably close and the records relocated to another area out of the Southwest. If there is no opposition from genealogists, researchers, and historians, NARA would be justified in closing the SW Branch in Fort Worth in the interest of “efficiency and cost-effectiveness.” It can and will happen unless you get involved. Accessibility to these records must come before efficiency and cost-effectiveness.”

## Forgotten Cemetery Rediscovered

Rusk, TX. When ninety-seven year old Hansome Smith died in August 1997 little did he suspect that his final request to be laid to rest with other members of his family could not be carried out.

Recorded burial plans made years before documented Mr. Smith's request to be buried in Weems Cemetery. The administrator of the care center where he spent his last 15 plus years of his life, made phone calls around Rusk trying to find someone who knew exactly where to find this place of eternal rest. She found few who even knew that such a place existed. Following directions given her she went south of East Loop 343 and searched. She found nothing. Mr. Smith was laid to rest in a pauper's grave in another local cemetery.

**The Cherokee County Informer** staff began a search for the Weems cemetery shortly afterwards. The Rusk Singletary Memorial library and Jacksonville Public library listed no Weems cemetery in their cemetery records. The search continued in the Cherokee County Courthouse county clerk records and through conversation with Rusk residents. The following information was found.

On May 12, 1875 Charles Weems and his wife Mary Ann Weems purchased 400 acres of land from F.M. Hicks. On

November 1, 1878 Mr. Weems and wife Mary Ann again purchased land. This time, 100 acres of land was purchased from Mary Timmons, widow of J.F. Timmons. The 500 acres of purchased land was part of the John Hundly survey, the J.F. Timmons survey, and the Z. Gibbs survey. The land is described as lying about one mile southeast of the town of Rusk.

On December 8, 1888, Charles Weems and wife Mary Ann sold most of the 500 acres of land to the Cherokee Land and Iron Company keeping only **19 acres on which the family home was located and a 1 acre tract of land upon which their family graveyard was situated.**

The Cherokee County map of the J.F. Timmons survey, abstract number 829 clearly shows a 1 acre cemetery with the largest segment located inside the city limits of Rusk.

Local residents were questioned about the cemetery. Lonzo Hicks, Jessie Simmons, Clearence Shears and Thurman Smith knew the exact location and volunteered to go there.

Located behind Wilcox Timber and Lumber Company about 800 feet south of Loop 343 is a heartbreaking sight. It gives the appearance of a dense forest instead of the final resting place of those who lie there. Headstones bearing the names

of those buried there are Wallace Weems, died 1908; Mattie L. Cumbo born October 13, 1881-died March 13, 1945. Mr. Hansome Smith's relatives found there are Blandena Smith died February 1966, Ollie Mae Smith VanZandt born 1920-died 1958, and Shirley Henry Smith.

Headstone dates prove that the cemetery was used as late as 1967. According to local residents many unidentified graves are located where only rocks or wood were used as grave markers and have since deteriorated. Others found are Mrs. Anna Polk Foreman age 80, died July 7, 1967 and Mary Ann Weems who died at age 58 and was buried in 1890, two years after she and her husband designated that property be used only as a cemetery.

Local resident, Lola Mallard, states that she remembers when this cemetery was in use and made calls making both the county and the city aware of its condition.

Under the roots of trees and thick layers of brush and leaves, lie people who were once a part of the history of Rusk and Cherokee County. Is this how they should be remembered? Do they deserve to be left in this manner suggesting that no one cares?

- A.T. Henson Yarbrough - first wife of Charles P. Yarbrough - she came to help with  
the sick, got sick herself and died in the Typhoid Fever Epidemic of 1887
- Mollie Bailey Yarbrough - second wife of Charles P. Yarbrough - cause of death  
unknown

## PETER ACKER - Confederate Veteran

Peter Acker was born 10 Dec 1823 in AL. He was the son of Joseph and Ruth Alexander Acker.

Peter married Martha Thompson in Bibb Co, AL on 26 March 1846. Some writers indicate that this family moved to Texas in 1848 while others state 1849. It is known from the 1850 census that the Peter Acker family was in Cherokee Co, TX living with his brother's family, Christopher Columbus Acker, when the 1850 census was taken.

Peter and Columbus Acker joined Co. C 3rd Texas Cavalry which was formed at Rusk, TX. The company left for duty in early July, 1861.

S.B. Barron speculated in his book, Lone Star Defenders, that Christopher Columbus and Peter Acker returned home when the 1862 conscription law was passed. However, Peter Acker seems to have not been present in his home because they had no children between Sept 1861 and Jan 1867.

The activities of the unit are recorded in the Cherokee Co, TX County Clerk's office. In addition, S.B. Barron's book mentioned above tells much about actions of the unit.

Peter and Martha Thompson Acker had eleven children. Nine of these children lived to adulthood. He died 16 Oct 1875 and is buried in Rocky Springs Cemetery near Dialville, Cherokee Co, TX.
