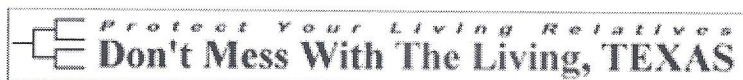
Editor's Letter

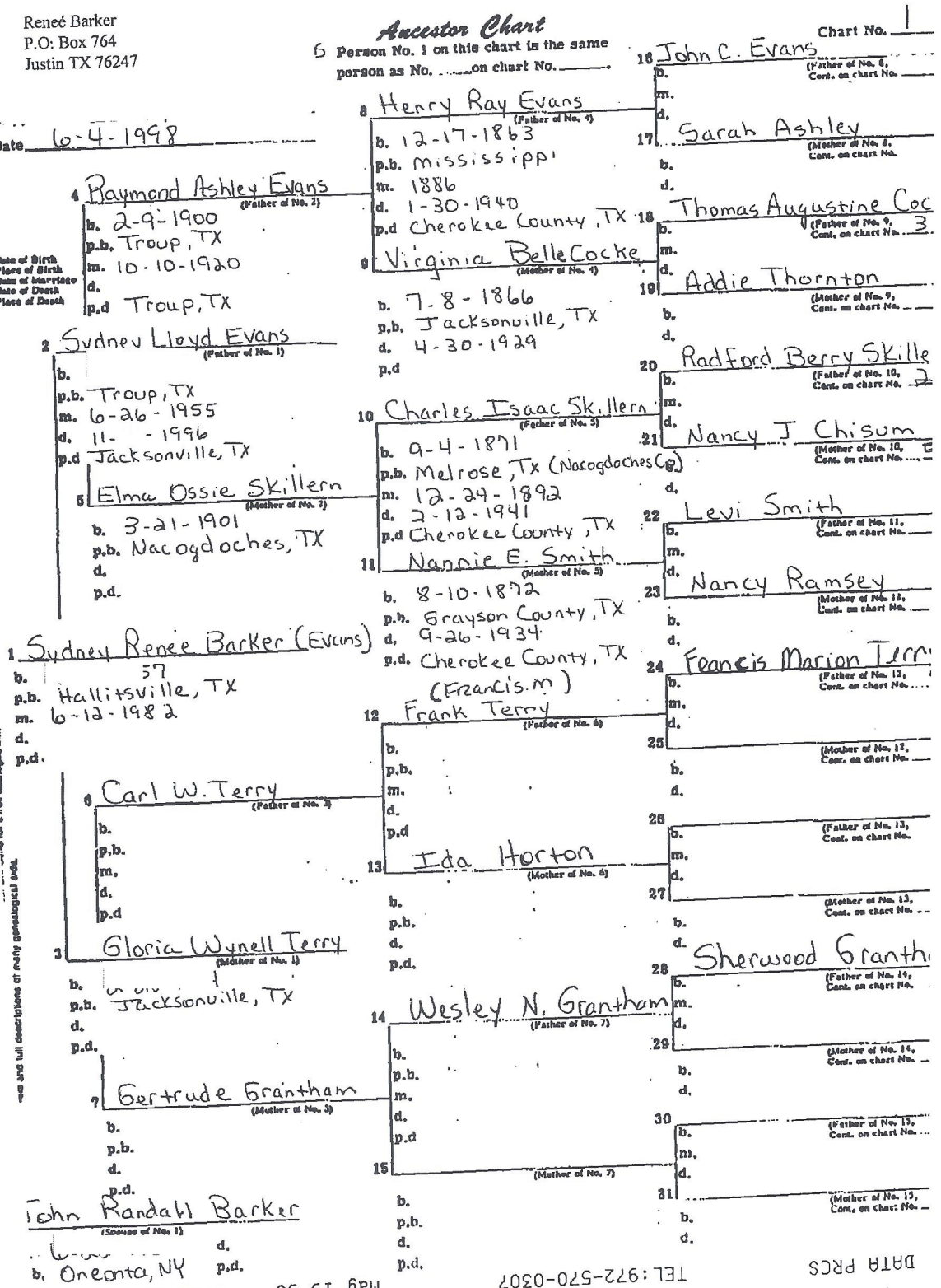

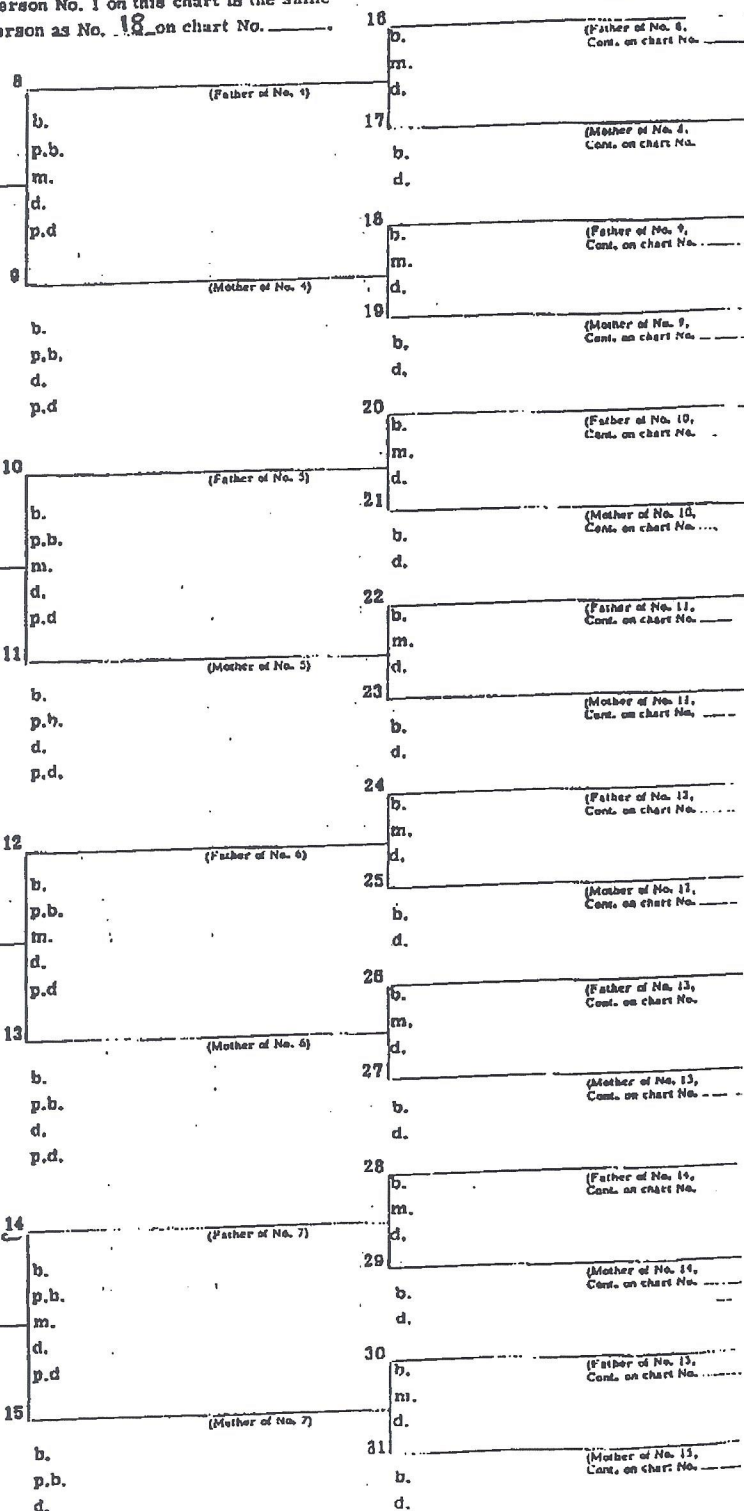

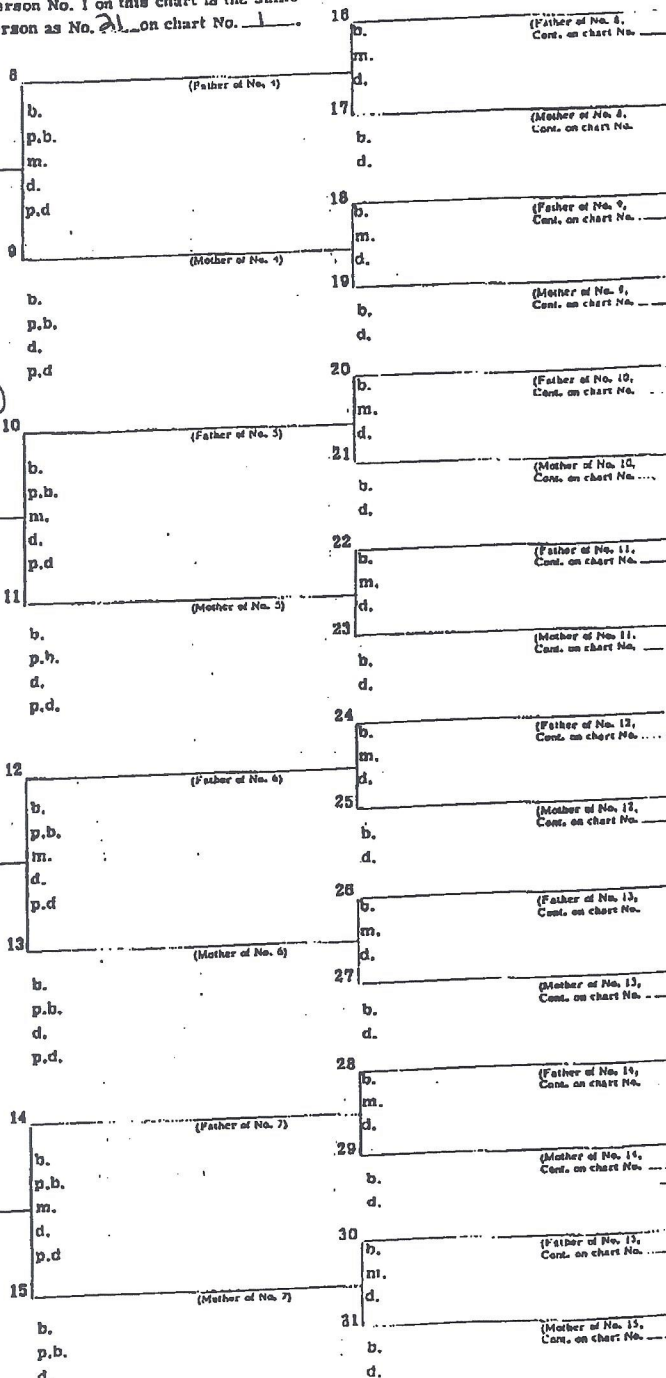

anna Curfew was the first child born to Maggie and D.W. She was born in San Saba at the Hotel. The Doctor was an old family friend and when she was born at 9 pm he quoted "curfew shall not ring tonight". There was a curfew law at the time in this small West Texas town. Curfew said her mother must have been out of her mind to allow them to name her Curfew, and further out of her mind to call her by that name. People would usually do a double take when they heard it for the first time. Traveling from San Saba to San Angelo during World War II, they stopped in Brady, Tx to get some refreshments. Sitting at the counter in a restaurant a sign was noticed about them stating "Let Us Cooperate On Curfew" (this was a military town and there was a curfew law). People in the restaurant could not understand why the family laughed so hard when they read this.

She was an excellent seamstress (having learned from her Mother-in-law) and made all the clothes for her two daughters and many for her one granddaughter.

Curfew's husband was manager of movie houses beginning during the days of silent movies. She would play the mood music on the organ at the theater.

She was a very accomplished organist and pianist. She was offered a scholarship to attend the Conservatory of Music in Cincinnati, Ohio, but she elected to get married instead. She had celebrated her 16th birthday one month before she married. Needless to say, she did not finish high school.

She was active in the Baptist Church. She played the piano for Sunday School and sang in the choir at church. She was called upon many times to sing at funerals. She usually sang with a dear friend Emily Diamond. Curfew had a beautiful alto voice.

Sally Blanton married four times.

1st to James McGaughey in 1862. He was killed in the Civil War.

2nd. to M. M. Petty in 1869.

3rd. to Lafayette Rodgers in 1859, and

4th to E. M. Sylvester in 1885.

When she was about 16 years old she had an encounter with Sam Houston in Rusk. From Robert Grant Burns: "A plaque is now being prepared for the site of Sam Houston's speech in Rusk in 1859, if I have the year correct. The article that tells this story, by the way, was written by Mother (Gladys Petty Burns). Mother said that she didn't have time to finish writing the whole article, but turned in the unfinished articles with the remaining notes, expecting a newspaper staff person to complete the article, but that it was published just as she turned it in, notes and all."

M. M. Petty left for the old homelace in Tennessee after 2 children had been born and never returned. Word came that he had died, no one knows for sure, where, or when. (Nettie Petty's Recollections)(Also see Notes on M. M. Petty)

From the Cherokee Co. Banner, 8-9-1935. "In addition to four children of her own, she has reared 12 stepchildren and three nieces. The soldiers who fought the battle of Santa Anna camped on her father's place and got food from her father for their horses. Her parents crossed the Mississippi in 1840. Could find plenty of Indian skulls and arrow heads."

"On the Leonard (grandparents) homestead eight miles south of Rusk on the Alto highway (now the Pearson place), where she grew to womanhood, there are several historical spots. Two are especially worthy of note: That of the celebrated Bowles Spring, supposed site where President Lamar and Chief Bowles signed the treaty which left Cherokee county free from the Indians. Then, Crosslyn's grave-yard, an old Indian burial ground, used to be on the hill just above the spring. When a child, she says that she used to pick up arrow heads, bits of pottery, and bright colored beads. Also, she remembers the stirring tales told of wealth that lay buried underneath the whispering pines of Grandfather Leonard's pasture." Brazier, Mildred. "Grannie Sylvester, Pioneer of County", Cherokee Co. Banner, (1930 or 1931).

He is buried at Myrtle Springs Church between Lone Star and Ponta. Lone Star is just north of Rusk. He had a younger brother, Elijah Bolton. Elijah had a daughter, Betty (Maybe Elizabeth) mentioned in NPR also a bunch of sisters-in-law.

From Robert Grant Burns: "Not sure about Neil's Landing, Florida. I guess we'll never know till we find some old records and maybe in 1880 census for either Titus, Franklin, or Cherokee County about 1890. Another possibility: Mama (Nettie Petty) hers may have had some memory of Nedy's (?) Landing, Missouri, from her trip to St. Louis in the early 1950's and somehow gotten i mixed up in Florida in her mind, or maybe her childhood crossing of the Mississippi. But of course there may really have been a Neil's Landing in Florida, but have not found it. There is a Neely's Landing in Missouri. It's on the Mississippi River in Cape Girardeau County,"

So it just occurs to me that Bryant must have been Aunt Annis' married name, not her maiden name. So I don't know the name of Mrs. Cannon's first husband. 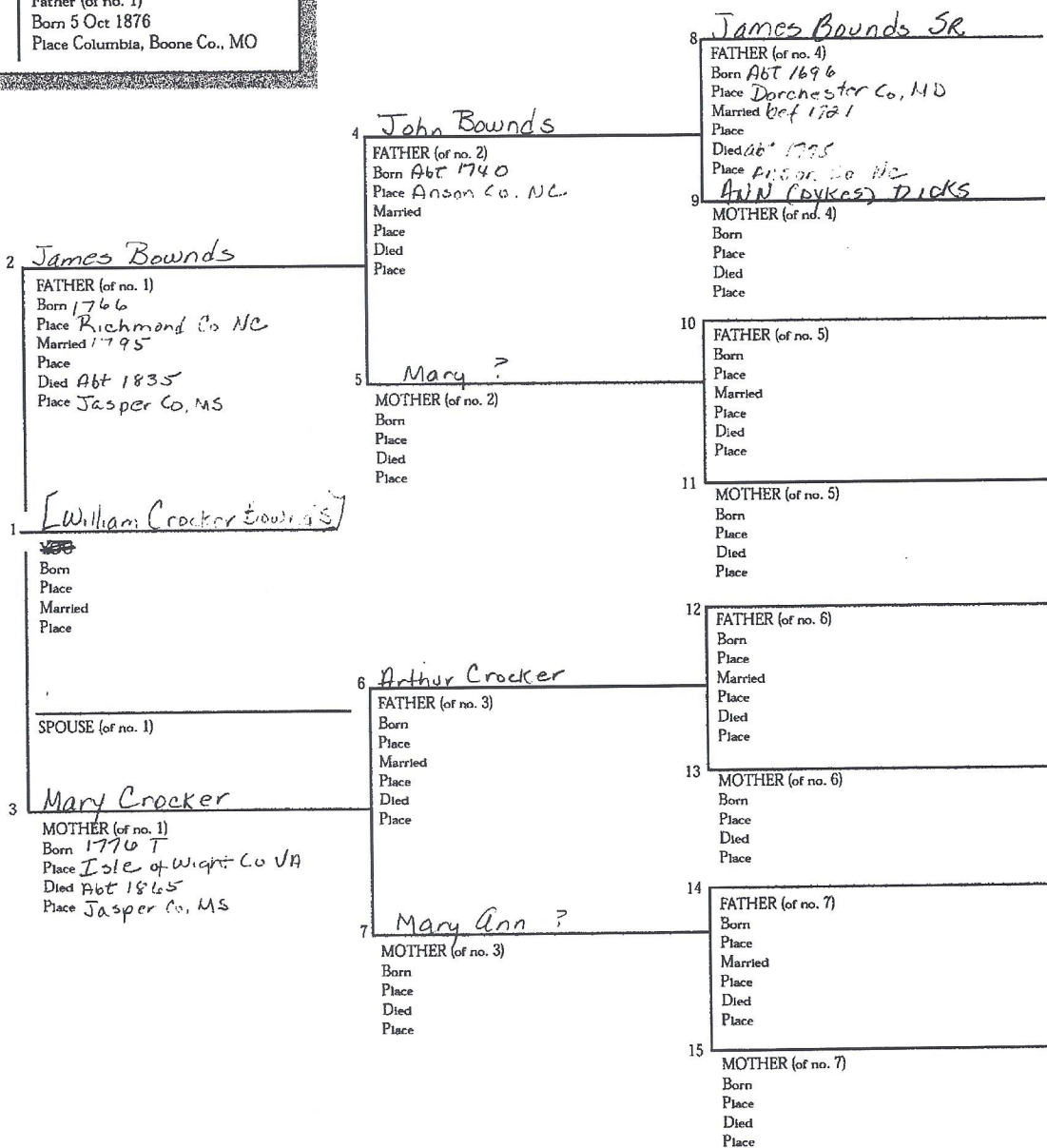
