1. The United States Postal Service continues to place additional restrictions and increased rates on Non Profit organizations, i.e., size, weight and count for certain set fees. The United States Postal Service has announced there will be an additional rate increase in the near future.

- (4) Forward all checks and monies received for membership fees or book orders to the Treasurer and notify the Editor of new members, membership renewals, and book orders.
- (5) Perform other related duties with mutual agreement of the Editor and Co-Editor.

- Did you have any special interests when you were growing up (sports, hobbies, crafts, etc.)?
- What kind of games did you play?
- What was your favorite toy?
- What other things did you do for fun (go to beach, park, movies, zoo, etc.)?
- Did your family ever take trips or go on vacation?
- Do you speak any foreign languages?
- Did you have family reunions?
- Who were your friends when you were growing up?
- Who were the close friends of the family?
- Describe the personalities of your family members.
- Are there any physical characteristics that run in your family?
- Were there any serious illnesses in your family?
- Do any illnesses run in the family?
