### Robert and Anna Huttash

Robert Huttash (1888-1960) was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, the son of Jacob and Francesca Kalina Huttash of Nispitz, Moravia (near Brno) who had come in through Ellis Island the previous year. Jacob was a cabinet maker by trade but moved to Medford in 1896 and farmed, also. By 1911 they were in Pratt, Kansas and Robert was a boilermaker for Rock Island Railroad. In December he married Anna Penrod, daughter of George and Emma Williams Penrod. Jacob (1839-1927) and Frances (1845-1928) spent the remainder of their lives in Pratt.

Robert was a hard worker and an innovative thinker but he was not a person to stay in one place too long — he liked to move on. When World War I came, they were homesteading in Baca County, Colorado. As father of three and color blind, he was exempt from service. After proving his claim, he sold out and moved back to Pratt. The trip was by covered wagon and the speed was determined by how fast the milch cow could walk.

After more years with Rock Island in Pratt and moves to Frontenac and Coffeyville, Robert moved to Shidler, Oklahoma and worked for another railroad, the Osage. Once he operated a large chicken farm in Missouri but this ended when the chickens were stolen. He was operating a welding shop in Nashville, Arkansas when the twins were born on January 1, 1928. This was expanded to Idabel, Oklahoma, where he ran a welding and machine shop — so he could keep the children busy and off the streets. Then the great depression of the 1930s set in. Business was bad, so he sold out.

Again in Kansas, the family raised wheat and broom corn near Manter. When there was a bumper crop and wheat was piled high, the price was low, 13 cents a bushel. This was the onset of the Dust Bowl, and after two successive years of crop failure, they moved to Hugo, Oklahoma. Robert and Raymond, the older sons, were able to obtain work on a project created to provide jobs. They were supposed to work 40 hours a week at 30 cents an hour, \$12 a week each, but often worked as much as 60 hours, to help support the family. It was an interesting job: they helped build the Sawyer Bridge over the Kiamichi River on US Highway 70 near Hugo.

Robert decided that the town needed a welding and machine shop. He and his sons took \$250 cash and an old Buick car to Dallas and made a trade for machinery to be delivered back to Hugo to start Industrial Iron Works, a successful venture in the manufacture of school bus bodies. At one time or another, most of the children worked for the business.

After several years, Huttash was looking for an expanded market and came to Jacksonville in 1939 and moved his family here in 1940. The business was located on West Larissa at a building formerly occupied by the Alexander Box and Basket Factory, and the Banner stated that Jacksonville had taken another step forward toward becoming an industrial center. Community leaders not only made everything convenient for their new firm, they even helped make the first sale, a school bus to Bullard School.

### Robert and Anna Huttash

Anna died at her home on West Larissa on May 15, 1962. Robert and Anna were parents of eight children.

- 1) Robert A. married Bonnie Bateman in Hugo. Their two children are Robert and Philip.
- 2) Raymond (1914-1963) married Mrs. Ogreta W. Derrett in 1947. Their three children are Mary Ann who married Major Tom Russell. Their daughters are Jamie and Jennifer. They live in Honolulu.  
Martha taught school nine years but is now employed by an oil company in Dallas.  
Ray married Robin Andrews. They live in Sanger and he is a carpenter.
- 3) Harry (1918-1971) married Mary Elizabeth Stone. Their children are Harolyn and Harry Jr. who are married and live near her in Dallas.
- 4) Annabell married Dr. John D. Polk (1917-1982). She works in the Art Department at Rusk State Hospital. They had two children.  
Hazel Ann who married Richard Ortyl; their daughters are Constance and Christie. They live in Baltimore.  
John D. Jr. married Mrs. DuAnne Doty Burden; their son John D. III was born in 1975.
- 5) Hazel married Dave Myers; they live in Louisville, Kentucky and are retired. Their four children are Davie, Sue, Mark, and Jeff who live nearby.
- 6) Lorene, a twin, married Eddie Meisner. They have a daughter, Mary, and live in Louisville, Kentucky.
- 7) Lawrence, a twin, married Margie White. They live in Jacksonville. They had two children Larry (1954-1973) and Timmy who married Mary Laska; they have two daughters, LeeAnn and Jennifer.
- 8) Ina Mae married Joe Musick who works for Southwestern Electric. Their daughter Kim married Ricky Hassell; they have a daughter Hayley Ann, and live near Maydelle. Their son, Joe Paul, is single and lives at home.

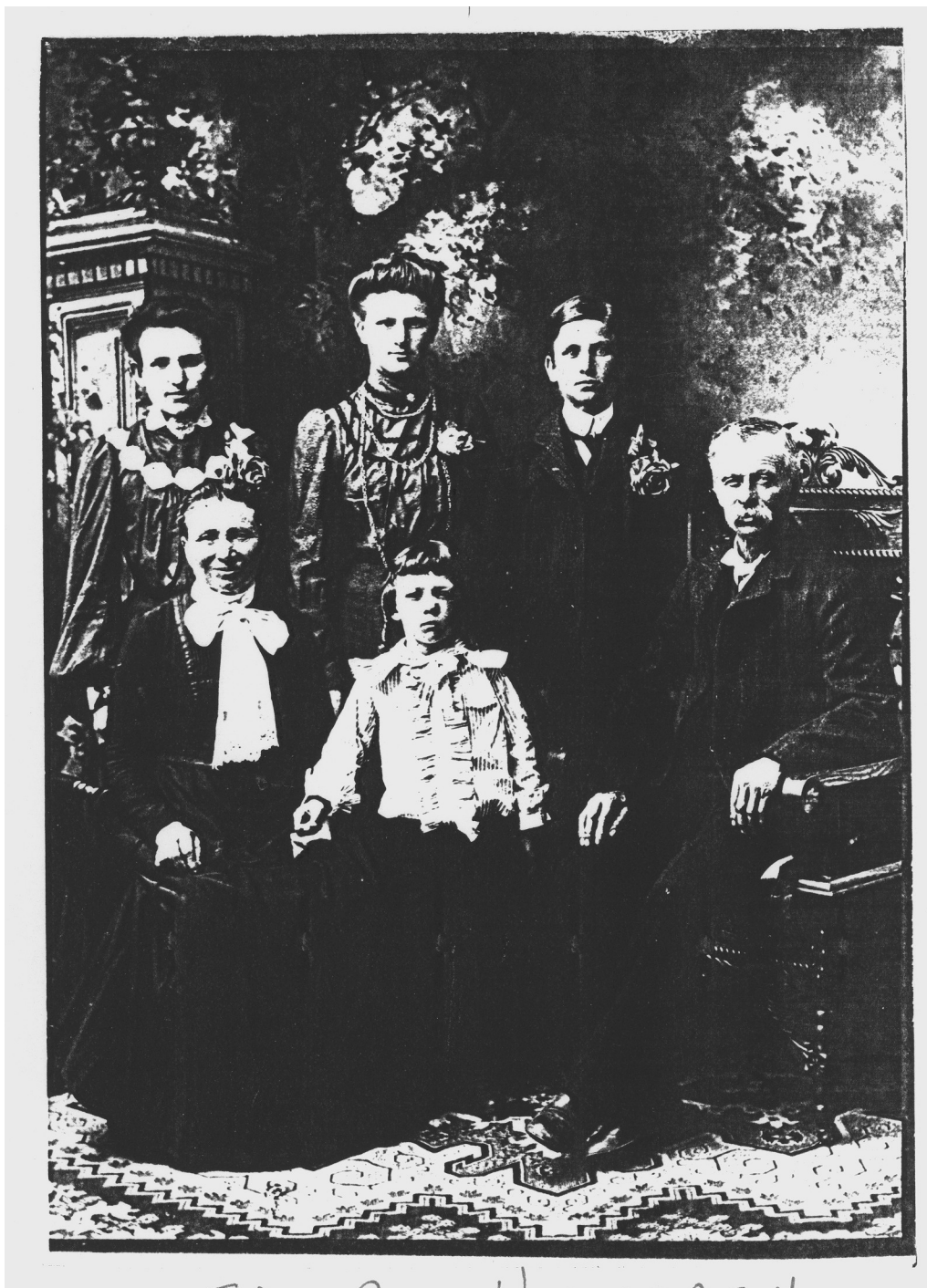

## Cook Cemetery at Alto, Texas

### Cook Cemetery at Alto, Texas

Cherokee County has more than one Cook Cemetery. The one south of Rusk was begun very early, in the 1840s, but my interest is the cemetery north of Linwood Community on the farm of Mrs. Pauline Selman Pitman. The earliest marked grave is for the first wife of Shelby H. Cook who died in 1857. He died in 1876, and his second wife, Betty, died in 1900.

This area just north of the Old San Antonio Road and a few miles from the Angelina River was the first settled in Cherokee County. It seemed an easy job to locate a deed, with three firm dates. Not so.

Deed records are located in the office of the County Clerk in Rusk. These records began in 1846, and today there are well over one thousand volumes. The index books are grantee - grantor and are in the same book. Index A begins in 1846 and continues to 1863. The books have been shrunk and maybe laminated but they can be very hard to read. Not all pages copied well. It seemed best to look for COOK in this book as both grantee (when he deeded it to the cemetery, hopefully) and as grantor (when he bought the land). There are many pages under letter C - but no Shelby Cook! For his wife to be buried there he was the probable owner. Or was he?

Index B for for the years 1863 - 1879 was then searched. There was no record of Shelby Cook!

Index C was searched next. The years were through 1888. Then a search was made through 1900 - with still no record of Shelby Cook.

At this time it seemed best to try the Cemetery Deed book - which is actually mostly churches, not cemeteries. But the churches owned the cemeteries - and as far as is known today there never was a church near Cook Cemetery. Several entries were under Church, M E South, for example. All these had to be read.

It appears this cemetery was not deeded out, but to be certain it would be necessary to read more deed records and to know exactly in which survey it is located.

Some things that could be done would be

- 1) read the tax rolls to see if Shelby Cook owned land or if he only paid a poll tax. If he owned land, the name of the survey would be shown. It is probably in the James Dill or Helena Kimble Survey, but this would need to be verified.
- 2) go to Cherokee County Appraisal District and go through their books to see if Mrs. Pauline Pitman is still the owner of the land. If so the name of the survey would be listed.
- 3) interview some of the older people in the community.

This Cook Cemetery is off the road, down a lane that now has new houses on it. Any one going to the cemetery would more than likely be noticed. That is one advantage now that there has been a lot of vandalizing in the county. Cook Cemetery can only be described as lovingly cared for. It is one of the prettiest in the county.

Finding cemetery deeds can be very time consuming. People have spent days looking for them. When they are found, the searcher often writes words like Lynches Chapel, Holcomb Cemetery, or Alto City Cemetery to make it easier for the next searcher. Maybe one day Cook Cemetery at Alto will be listed in the index to Cemetery Deed Record Volume A.
