120 Year Old Album Answers 16 Year Old Letter

This beautiful old photo album inherited from my Mother recently answered a 16 year old letter that accidentally fell in to my hands a few weeks ago.

Last month my young cousin Kati Sory Newton came to town for an all day genealogy exchange regarding the Sory family history. I have been so pleased that a young relative is so interested in our mutual research. Her great grandfather William Horace Sory and my Mother were First Cousins.

Among the many documents she brought was a letter dated April 10, 1996 that had somehow come to her from a woman named Pat Everette. It said, among other things, that she found the enclosed photo copies from an antique trunk in Denton, Texas. Some of the photos were labeled Sory and she was writing to all possible Sorys who might live in areas where her great grandmother Maggie Bowen had lived.



Kati and I were looking through our ancient album when we discovered that some of Pat's photo copies were duplicates of photos in the album, although mistakenly labeled. But the "kicker" was the picture in the album of "Aunt Mag Bowen." We must be related to Mag Bowen for her picture to be in my Mother's family album. For some unknown reason I figured I needed to check my maternal grandmother's records. Her maiden name was Henry and I have not followed that family line as closely as I have the Sorys. And some time in the past the name Aunt Maggie sounded familiar.

A good decision. My grandmother Mattie Lee Henry Sory was the daughter of William Harvey Henry and Melvina Jane Lemmons. Melvina Lemmons was the daughter of David Lemmons and the sister of Sarah Margaret "Maggie" Lemmons who married Wm Jefferson Bowen. So Maggie Bowen was my grandmother's Aunt. And according to the 1996 letter, Maggie once lived in Jacksonville, Texas-my Mother's home town.

The bottom line is that Pat's great grandmother was the sister of my great grandmother. So after the detective work I wanted to get in touch with Pat. Her 1996 letter had her address in Concord, California and a telephone number. I tried the telephone number. A woman answered. Are you Pat Everette? Yes. Pat, this is Richard Sory Robertson and we are third cousins!

I told her of Kati's visit and her possession of the photo copies and the 1996 letter. And when "Aunt Mag Bowen" was in this 120 year old album I really had to check it out. A few days later I sent her all the details, a pedigree chart, correct names to her photo copies, and our picture of Aunt Maggie Bowen.

As my friend Harold Lemburg used to say: "You never know from where you sit, who's gonna spit from the balcony." Thanks, old photo album!

One area not spotlighted, was newspapers—a topic with vast resources important to family history.

Not every newspaper has been scanned, but almost daily, digitized repositories expand. There are a number of free options, including at RootsWeb (which is always free).

(worldwide) Wikipedia maintains links to free and for pay digitized online newspapers. The page is built entirely by knowledgeable researchers, such as you. It can be edited at any time, allowing for dynamic and real-time corrections and additions.

One of the more ambitious digitization projects is through Chronicling America, which offers grants to organizations who wish to participate (see the National Digital Newspaper Program). Research is conducted through the US Newspaper Directory, 1690–Present database.

Co-produced by the National Digital Newspaper Program and the Library of Congress, the directory records a list of known historical U.S. newspapers (major), and a variety of digitized images from 1836–1922, representing:

Arizona, California, District of Columbia, Florida, Hawaii, Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Vermont, Virginia, and Washington

While searching, investigate the Advanced Search Tab, which allows:

- Searching by specific states, newspapers and / or date ranges
- Limiting searches to specific pages or front pages
- Entering keywords using "any, all or specific phrase" options
- Specifying that search words must occur within 5, 10, 50, or 100 words of each other

Once a particular newspaper has been located, click on it to expand. You will then be free to save your selection to your computer.

In addition to Chronicling America, several projects exist for specific states, such as at West Virginia University Libraries, which received a grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities to digitize West Virginia newspapers from 1836-1922.

Major Newspaper Repositories (subscription)

This article wouldn't be complete without mentioning the largest newspaper repositories. Although there is cross-over, you'll find each collection is unique-and searching is generally free. In many cases, you'll see a snapshot of the image (called a thumbnail) and be able to determine if you wish to subscribe.

Some claim impressive numbers, such as GenealogyBank, with over one billion genealogical records, and NewspaperArchive, which advertises as the world's largest newspaper collection. Most, including

Ancestry.com and NewsBank, partner with an expanding number of publishers.

Researchers often express frustration at finding newspaper records. Why? Notices may be missed by search engine~ which misinterpret old type, particularly if there are obstacles to overcome, such as smudges, font, and spelling variations. The key to a successful search, is persistence.

Don't assume a name was recorded as you would have preferred. Publishers are creative. They may have abbreviated, omitted portions of names or referred to people by titles or relationships. For example, daughter of our late president [assumes names are known}, estate of Natl Greene, Gen. Smith, Mrs. Jones, relict of Mr. Adams, Sgt M'Donald, Woman of Colour
