The application to probate this will dated 3 January 1874 was filed 15 November 1879, and Evan Evans is on the 1880 Mortality Schedule.

County of Cherokee) Know all men by these presents that the great uncertainty of life, Therefore for the great love I have and bear toward my two sons E. G. Evans and for Calvin Evans, I do therefore bequeath unto them all my property both personal & real at my death & should I dye before them then and in case of their death before myne then and in that event my property is to be divided equally between my other heirs which I have by my lawful - - - Nancy Evans, decd as the heirs of her body & I do appoint Edward Evans my true & lawful executor to carry out the contents and design of this my last will and testament and all the acts my said executor may do in order to carry out this spirit and title of these presents shall be legal and binding.

Given under my hand and seal using scroll for seal on this January 3d day of January 1874 one thousand Eight hundred and seventy-four.

Comment: This probate minute book has no index, so these nearly 700 pages are like a can with no can opener. There are no loose papers on file. Perhaps later on in the book there will be final settlement and distribution.

This applies only to descendants of R. E. "Bud" Richardson and his wife whose marriage record was recorded in 2000 after being unrecorded in the Courthouse at Rusk for 128 years. It is now on record. Bud married Emma Eudora Woolley, daughter of Justin Woolley and Amelia Evans. Amelia was daughter of above Evan Evans and Nancy Selman. Amelia married first Elias Walker, then Justin Woolley. She is buried in Evans Cemetery north of Linwood, Alto, Texas.

### Abner Jewel Richardson

Abner Jewel Richardson, son of James "Jimmy" Reuben and Sarah Elizabeth Acrey Richardson, m. Ila Erma McConnell, Dec. 12, 1929. Erma was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. M. McConnell of Alto. They have a son, Jack Kenneth Richardson Sr., m. Syble Marie Fitts, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Tom Fitts, Alto, Nov. 24, 1955; a grandson, Jack Kenneth "Ken" Richardson Jr. They live in Lufkin, Tex.

Abner Jewel Richardson took his bride to live in the large ancestral home of his parents. He has never lived any place else. His father passed away when Jewel was-a-teenager. His motne lived to an advanced age in the same home. They are buried in the family plot in the Harrison-Armstrong Cemetery in Alto, Tex. Abner Jewel and Erma still reside on the Richardson land in Alto.

Jewel had one brother, J. W. Richardson, deceased. His wife, Adele, has her home in Alto. They have J. M. Richardson of Houston.

Jewel rode a horse named "Old Ceilum" to school and tied him to a cedar tree by the corner of the campus. That tree stands there today.

James "Jimmy" was very active in the Alto Baptist Church, was a Deacon, and also a Trustee of the school. A beautiful tribute was written in memory of him by church and school officials who are now deceased. He was an outstanding carpenter in his day and many buildings standing today attest to his skill and workmanship. Jewel's parents had surrey's "with the fringe on top" when he was a small boy. His mother was a charter member of the Alto Methodist Church.

Jewel had black families living on the farm and had many horses and mules, for they farmed extensively in those days. Now tractors and other modern equipment are used.

Jewel worked 35 years as a heavy equipment operator on country roads. Many fine bridges now attest to his skill in supervising the construction. He is retired and enjoys taking care of his cattle on the ranch.

Jewel and Erma are active members of Alto First Baptist Church. They still live in the ancestral home on the land. In 1975 Jewel and Erma were presented the Family Land Heritage Certificate by John C. White, Texas Commissioner of Agriculture. The certificate is given in honor of land having been in the possession of the same family m?re than 100 years. In this case it has been 131 years since it was bought from Jose Mora, vho acquired it from His Excellency, the Governor of Mexico, as it was in public domain in the early 1830's. - Erma Richardson

### **The Pioneer Richardson Story**

The original Richardson farm and ranch was founded in 1853 in Cherokee County near Alto, Tex.

In 1850, John William Richardson m. Ann Catherine Watters in Perry Co., Ala. Two years later, they and six other families moved to Cook's Fort in East Texas near Rusk. They took six weeks traveling by home-built carts and wagons to make the trip. They stopped at good creeks to wash clothes, cook food, rest, and let the live stock graze and rest. They spent the first year at Cook's Fort. Like so many other pioneers, they were seeking a better life, and the area seemed to be what they were looking for.

John William purchased 236 acres of land for 10 cents per acre in 1853 in the Jose Maria Mora Survey northeast of Alto and moved his family there. He and his slaves cut trees and hauled the virgin timber by ox-drawn cart to a sawmill near Rusk to be made into lumber to build a large, nice home to house his family, which grew to be a large one over the years. The lumber was planed by hand after it was sawed. The house still stands by the road which is now the busy US 69. The slaves were housed in good quarters also.

After only a few years of the family's living in Texas, the Civil War started. John William volunteered for service in the Confederate Army. During his service he was promoted to Captain. While he was gone, his family and their slaves kept the farm and ranch running smoothly. Even after the war, when the slaves were given their freedom, they stayed on at the Richardson farm and ranch because of the good and fair treatment they received from the family.

Ann Catherine, spun the thread, wove the material, and dyed it to make her husband a new suit to have when he returned home from the war. He was wounded, but made it home by walking, as did all the discharged soldiers then.

Many types of crops were grown on the farm, also much livestock. Capt. Richardson willed 80 acres to one son, James Reuben "Jimmy." The 80 acres were passed on to Abner Jewel, Reuben's son (see Abner Richardson family history).

### John William Richardson

John William Richardson (b. Nov. 24, 1826, d. May 7, 1896), a Captain in the Confederate Army, m. Ann Catherine Watters (b. Aug 28, 1832, d. September, 1906), Oct. 23, 1/51 in Perrytown, Ala. had 10 children and came to Texas in 1852.

The family came to Cherokee Co., Tex. from Perryville (Spratt) Perry Co. Ala. in an oxen drawn wagon caravan with her parents William and Amy Watters and about 30 other families. The group settled for a short while at Copk's Fort near Rusk before moving to Alto.

In 1853 the Richardsons bought land near Ann's parents. John William, being a wagon builder, built a log home from timber cut on his own land. He hauled the timber to Rusk where it was sawed into lumber, brought it back to the site, where it was hand-planed for building. The cabin was built with square nails. In later years, a son, James Reeves Richardson, moved the home to another part of the property. Although added to and modernized, the home still stands and is the home of one of his sons, Jewel Richardson.

John William and Ann Catherine Richardson are buried beside her parents in the Harrison- Armstrong Cemetery, Alto.

James Reeves Richardson, one of 10 children of John William and Ann Catherine Watters, m. Sarah Elizabeth Acrey Oct. 5, 1865. Her parents, Abner Donald and Harriet Ophelia Dawson Acrey, were early settlers in Nacogdoches, Tex., from Georgia and Alabama. The couple had John William and Abner Jewel (see histories). After James Reeves' death in 1913, his widow continued to live in the old homeplace, where she d. in 1957 at age 85. Both are buried in the Harrison- Armstrong Cemetery, Alto.

John William Richardson (b. Oct. 29, 1882, Alto, d. Oct 13, 1966, buried in the Atoy Cemetery) m. Exa Adele Williams Dec. 31, 1924, in Nacogdoches, had James Malone, b. Jan. 14, 1930. Exa Adele was a daughter of Charles Malone Williams (b. March 7, 1867, Linwood, d. June 22, 1924) and Lula Elizabeth Cole (b. April 18, 1873, Mt. Zion, d. May 25, 1955), who m. Sept. 16, 1891. Her grandparents were Aaron Shannon and Hester Addis Cole and William Malone and Cornelia Selman Williams, who reared large families in the East Texas area.

John William Richardson lived his entire life in Alto and was a rural mail carrier 47 years. The Alto Herald printed the following tribute to him when he died:

*"There are many tributes that could be paid to this good man, who was kind, humble and unassuming. He was first of all a family man, gentle, and loving. To his many friends, in all walks of life, he was a loyal person, giving of himself in any way that could be of assistance. He expected no favors in return. "*

John William and Exa Adele Richardson were life-time members and workers in First Baptist Church in Alto.

James Malone Richardson (b. Jan. 15, 1930) m. Marilyn Henry (b. Feb. 5, 1933, Dubach, La.) of Rusk Dec. 25, 1951, had James Malone Jr., b. May 30, 1957, and Rhoda, b. Oct. 3, 1960. James Malone was the only child of John William and Exa Adelle Richardson. James Jr. is a petroleum engineer and holds Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees from Texas A. and M. University. - Marilyn Henry Richardson.
