John Versluis is the Dean of the Texas Heritage Museum at Hill College and has spearheaded the museum since 2005. John oversees three separate divisions: the Texas Heritage Museum Galleries & Collection, the Historical Research Center, and the Hill College Press, he also serves as an Adjunct Instructor in History at Hill College.



Carol Taylor is the former director of the Northeast Texas Genealogy center in Greenville, TX. She is a sixth generation Texan. Her sessions on beginning genealogy are titled "So You Want to Climb Your Family Tree?"



Dr. Richard Hackney received his undergraduate degree from Texas Southern University, Pharm.D degree in Clinical Pharmacy from the University of Tennessee, College of Pharmacy and is a registered Pharmacist. by the State of Texas. He is a member of the Cherokee County Historical Commission.



Peggy Lloyd is a former teacher of English and holds Master's degrees in English and history. She served in the United States Peace Corps in the late 1960s in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, and also taught English in Germany, France and England in the 1970s. She now serves as the Archival Manager, Southwest Arkansas Regional Archives, Washington, Arkansas.



Kevin Klaus has a background in Anthropology, Archaeology, and Public History from the University of New Mexico, and currently working on his certification to become a certified genealogist. Over the last 12 years he has served as one of the lead researchers in the Texas General Land Office Archives and Records Program Area. He has searched the early Court of Claims files and archival collection of personal letters of early soldiers and pioneers.



Dr. George Avery has a Ph.D. from the University of Florida, an M.A. from the Southern Illinois University-Carbondale, and a B.A. from Marquette University. All degrees are anthropology. His research interests include Spanish colonial archaeology and cemeteries. His field experience includes the U.S. (midwest, southwest, northeast and southeast), the Dominican Republic, and Haiti. He was the Station Archaeologist at Los Adaes State Historic Site in Louisiana—18th century capitol of Texas, from 1995 to 2005, and since October, 2007, staff archaeologist at SFA.

Kaye Slover has been the Web Page Editor for the Cherokee County Genealogical Society since 2004. She teaches music in the Nacogdoches Texas Public Schools.

David Henderson is the Second Vice President of the Cherokee County Genealogical Society and leads our efforts to locate and document cemeteries in Cherokee county, Texas.

Definitions Used in Research:

ADMINISTRATION:	a process which involves the collection, management distribution of an estate.
BOUNTY LAND:	land awarded as a bonus to attract soldiers to sign up or as payment in addition to or in lieu of wages for military service.
CODICIL:	a supplement to a will.
COLLATERAL:	descended from a common ancestor but through a different line.
DOWER:	widow's life estate in her husband's property
ESTATES:	the sum total of a person's real and personal property
GRANTEE:	buyer of land
	GRANTEE: seller of land
INDENTURE:	1) a deed; 2) an agreement of apprenticeship; 3) an agreement by which a person sold his labor for passage.
INTESTATE:	a person who dies without a valid will.
PARTITION:	division of common property by two or more persons.
QUITCLAIM:	release of all title, interest or claim to ownership in specific property; transfer title to someone else.
PROBATE:	originally the process of proving a will valid. In US law, inclusive term to describe all matters over which a court of probate has jurisdiction.
TESTATE:	a person who dies without a valid will

When in doubt check *Black's Law Dictionary* or other law dictionary at library.

WHEN TO LOOK FOR GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS

Any time your ancestor may have had some dealing with the Federal government, you should look for a record. The best place to start is at the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) website, www.archives.gov. Go to the Research Our Records page, scroll down to Research Your Ancestry. There you will find descriptions of documents held by the NARA, but you will be directed to www.Fold3.com or www.FamilySearch.org. Below is a list of circumstances in which your ancestor may have a record at the National Archives.

Was involved in military activities

Had claims for losses based on military actions

Was involved in any dealings or transactions with the government, including criminal cases

Settled in a frontier area

Suffered from any disaster

Sought relief from an “unjust” law or code – local, state, national

Attended a government institution/joined a government organization

Was a Native American or involved with Native Americans

Was a member of a wave of immigrants

Was a member of a minority or oppressed group

Was involved in transportation, commerce, or banking

Served as a government official

Records pertaining to interaction with state and local governments will probably be kept at the state archives or at the local courthouse.

PERIODICAL SOURCE INDEX (PERSI)

PERSi is the largest subject index to genealogy and local history periodical articles in the world. Created by the staff of the Allen County Public Library in Fort Wayne, Indiana, it is recognized as a vital tool for genealogical researchers. Articles in 11,000 periodical titles (including 3,000 defunct titles) published by thousands of local, state, national and international genealogy and local history societies, there are more than 2.25 million entries by surname or location.

PERSi is free at HeritageQuestOnline.com available through TexShare at your local library.

PERSi is a subject index to articles, **not an every name or every word index.**

Restoration of Martha Ellen Hackerd's Grave

This is the story of the restoration of the grave covering on my grandmother, Martha Ellen Hackerd's grave by her great grandson, Dr. John L. Marsh on May 9, 2015.

My grandfather (Dad's father) moved his family from Indiana to Jacksonville, Texas in about 1904. H. H. Hackerd was a brick mason. He worked with C. R. Kelley to build Lon Morris College with Twin Towers. Also, he worked on the Baptist Church and sidewalks in Jacksonville. (The sidewalks have C.R. Kelley on them 'til yet!!)

In 1914 this brick mason's beloved wife died at age 60 years 10 months and was buried in Larissa Cemetery. H.H. Hackerd covered her grave with a cement slab and gently placed his right hand print in the damp cement on the lower right corner of it. He returned to Indiana leaving his wife and youngest daughter at Larissa Cemetery near Jacksonville. Henry Harrison Hackerd died in 1927 in Indiana and was buried there.

I don't remember when my Daddy, Hoyt Hackerd showed me the hand print and told me about his dad, but we would carefully dust it off and place my hand there. Through the years my children, my grandchildren and now my great grandchildren have placed their hands there.

I discovered a few weeks ago that the corner hand print part was broken off from the main slab. My son was visiting from San Antonio. We lifted the cover off and took it to my home to take care of it until John came again on Mother's Day weekend May 2015.

John said the restoration of the grave covering would be his "project". It was!, as pictures taken show the process of work as we replaced the hand print and added mine at the left corner. I believe John's great grandfather would have said "Good job son"!

I thanked him so much for the preservation of part of our heritage!
