Lane Family Research

On Monday, July 10, 2017, Dr. Deborah L. Burkett called from the Cherokee County Historical Commission and asked me to meet Regina Lane at the Jacksonville Public Library to help Ms. Lane with the research on her LANE family research. Ms. Lane is from Sacramento CA.

Ms. Lane had a pedigree chart, a page from the California Death Index and several certified copies of birth and death records. We discussed her research and made copies of pages from several Jacksonville City Directories. We scanned a number of records and sent them to her and me by email.

Her father Richard Lane was born March 29, 1949 in Berkeley, California. Married (1st) December 21, 1968 at Oakland Ca. and died July 24, 1993. He was the son of Richard Lane and Hattie Hill.

Her grandfather was Richard Lane born January 18, 1914 at Route 5, Box 217, Jacksonville, Cherokee County, TX to G. W. Lane (a negro aged 36) and Ida Sarden (a negro aged 33), (both born in Cherokee County) according to a delayed birth certificate dated October 13, 1944, witnessed by Elderron Dinah Tolbert and ordered recorded by James I. Perkins, County Judge of Cherokee County and filed for record October 19, 1944 at 9:15 A.M. and recorded Oct. 19. 1944 at 3:25 P.M. by Melvin Sessions, Clerk County Court, Cherokee County, Texas. The certificate states that Ida was the mother of 11 children. Richard Lane died November 2, 1959 at Alameda, CA.



Note that G. W. Lane is the father of eleven children and Ida Sarden is the mother of six children, then G.W. Lane had 5 children by other women.

Lane Family Research

The elder Richard Lane died November 2, 1959 in Oakland, Alameda County California. His body was removed to Mercy Funeral Home, Jacksonville, Texas. That was the clue that brought Regina Lane to Cherokee County, Texas to continue her research. She had no idea of a Texas connection until she saw this information.

Ms. Lane also had a delayed birth certificate for another son of G.W. Lane and Ida Sarden. This was George Wesley Lane, Jr. born at Jacksonville, Texas at 102 E. Lane St., a male, legitimate, born December 19, 1920 to George Wesley Lane, a Negro aged 44 born in Rusk Co. TX who worked as a laborer and Ida Sarden a negro aged 33 at time of birth, born in Rusk Co., TX who worked as a domestic. The affidavit was signed by Ida Lane, witnessed by Lizzie Gray, notarized by O.C. Otter, ordered to be recorded by H.T. Brown, Co. Judge of Cherokee County, Filed for record Feb 27, 1943 at 2 P.M. and recorded March 4, 1943 at 1:30 p.m. by Melvin Session, Clerk County Court, Cherokee County Texas.

So it would seem that Regina Lane's great grandfather was George Wesley Lane. I began searching for George Wesley Lane on Ancestry.com and got nowhere. Ms. Lane mentioned her search revealed census records in the name of Wesley Love and Wes Kane and I, at first, did not understand the significance of these findings.

We made copies of the names of Lane in several copies of the Jacksonville City Directory for the 1930s and 1940s and notice that Wes Lane was listed with wife Ida.

I was stumped. We agreed to meet again the following morning to visit the Community Funeral Home to see if they more information in their files.

I went home and started to work on the problem.

I have found that I cannot fully understand a family without using a computer genealogy program. When I got home I started a file for the Lane family and began entering the information furnished by Regina Lane and down loading information in Family Tree Maker version 2014.1 using Ancestry Com. By entering many details such as first, middle and last names, city, county, state, names of spouse, children, parents; race and sex, I began searching George Wesley Lane.

Please remember that the information in these genealogy data bases comes from hand written documents that are indexed by people. So errors are made in indexing. Searching Ancestry.com will result in many possible matches. So I must review many results and evaluate them before merging them into my file.

So if George Wesley Lane does not give good results, I modify my search for Wesley Lane and I got the 1930 census listing, Wesley, 49; Ida, 42; and daughters Marion, 21; Emma, 17; Trainna, 16; Bernicia, 12 and son, G.W, 8; living at 239 Dorothy Street, Jacksonville City, on April 5, 1940. Wesley worked as a laborer on a pipe line. Marion and Emma worked as cooks in private homes. They owned their home valued at \$1280. Wesley was 18 and Ida was 14 at the time of their marriage.

George worked as a laborer at a box & basket factory for 100 weeks and had a high school education.

So now I had records of Wesley Land and Green Wesley Lane both at R.F.D. 1, Jacksonville, Texas on September 12, 1918.
