The records of this office show W. S. Ansley of Longview, Gregg County Texas, executed an application for Confederate Pension August 11, 1915. At that time he stated he was 72 years old - born in Randolph, County, Georgia. He had been a resident of Texas since 1878. The application was approved under File No. 32291 and he drew a pension until his death in Longview on May 2, 1922.

Mr. Ansley stated he enlisted in 1861 in Company "F", 5th Georgia Regiment of Infantryand served until May, 1865.

The application for pension was approved on the following report furnished this office by the Adjutant General, War Department, Washington, D. C.

"The records show that Wesley S. Ansley, private and Sergeant, Co. F, 5th Georgia Infantry, C. S. A., enlisted May 10, 1861, and that he was paroled at Greensboro, N. C., May ln 1865."
