This is to advise that under the law persons are not premitted to forward Confederate Pension Warrants, but they must be returned to this office when the pensioner is not at the address given on the warrant. Warrants must be mailed to the pensioner where they are visiting, and I am asking that in the future you have Mrs. Palmer notify this office at any time she visits in some other town in order that her pension warrants may be mailed direct to her.


