

LOVELADY everend Cletus Lovela

Reverend Cletus Lovelady, age 77 of Crockett, formerly of Amarillo, passed away Tuesday, June 15, 2010 in The Concierge Nursing Home in Houston. Reverend Lovelady was born March 9, 1933 in Weches, Texas to Otis Frances and Annie Mae Lovelady. He moved to Amarillo, Texas at 5 years old and graduated from Amarillo High School in 1951.
