Ida Maudine “Dene” Nevill Manning, of Lubbock, died Saturday, March 22, 2008, in Lubbock. Funeral services were at 2 p.m. Monday, March 24, at The North Madison Church of Christ in Madisonville. Lanier Stevens officiated. Burial was in The Madisonville City Cemetery.

Mrs. Manning was born Sept. 5, 1928 in Bryan. She married the love of her life, Paul Manning, in December of 1947. He preceded her in death only four months ago. Mrs. Manning was a member of Broadway Church of Christ in Lubbock and has been a member of North Madison Church of Christ in Madisonville.
