Mary Jane Gilman was born in Gainesville, Cook County, Texas the year 1846. She was dark skinned, dark eyed and had black hair. It was said that she was part Indian. To date we have not proved this. Many of her ancestors to date carry this trait, (the dark skin), however at this time period lots of folks relish the "tanned" look.

This lady was not to be taken lightly, as she was a very strong willed, very high strung, very versatile lady. These traits made her very capable of leading the life she was to lead. They also made her very difficult to get along with.

She was quite the manager and took the reins more than once to help in making the living. There was not much for females to do at that time to earn money. Mary Jane was known to do whatever she had to do. Sometimes this meant doing the wash of other families. No easy chore as they did not have the modern conveniences we know today. I can well imagine that water was not that easy to come by.

She would decorate her house quite nicely each time they had to move, and this was to be quite frequent. This also was no easy task, as most belongings had to be sold or left behind when moving. She always managed to come through and always kept a nice home for them to enjoy.

They were to live in several West Texas towns, one being Dublin, the year 1906. It was there that their son Bill and Hattie Rose Teague met and married. They lived with Jim and Mary for a time. This proved to be a hard task for a young bride, as having mentioned, Mary Jane was difficult to get along with.

In all fairness to Mary Jane, these stories were related by daughter-in-laws. No easy task in any time period, in-laws to get along. The hardships of the time would well have made tempers short fused, of anyone, be they Irish or Indian, or the children, all grown up, of the Irish and Indian.

There are many chapters to be added to Mary Jane's story. Some told by her daughters and some by granddaughters. We hope to add each one.

Again I wish to give credit where credit is due. Our own Helen King. Helen has spent many hours diligently researching. Many hours getting these stories recorded to be cherished and remembered.
